Why Work Here

We partner with local nonprofits to support our mission and have two local partners functioning out of our campus on 8th Ave. (Working Food and Beaten Path Compost).

Requirements

- Monday-Thursday morning availability (between the hours 9AM-1PM)
- Ability to work with a diverse group of individuals of varying physical and intellectual ability levels
- Desire to learn about horticulture, vocational horticulture, horticultural therapy, landscaping
- Ability to lift at least 50 pounds
- Attention to detail, ability to oversee and direct work groups or volunteers when needed
- Ability to motivate others in group work
- Ideally 15-20 hours per week

Daily Responsibilities

- General nursery maintenance: pruning, fertilizing, sweeping, propagating, planting, watering
- Organizing work groups/volunteers to complete daily tasks
- Assisting with wholesale orders: picking out desirable plants, removing dead leaves, pruning and fertilizing
- Working with and assisting customers when needed
- Organizing materials, keeping work spaces clean

Potential areas for learning: landscaping and nursery management, Florida native plants and ecology, horticultural therapy, vocational horticulture, marketing and social media, community outreach, sustainability work, and more!
